Moving people who are homeless from dependency to economic self sufficiency and personal fulfillment through the power of personal relationships

About 17% of the 3,300 homeless Guests we serve each year have mental and/or physical disabilities.



In addition to extensive case management — the homeless Guests served through the Angels program have benefit of our Core Services:

- Meals at the Crossroads Kitchen
- Assistance securing their legal identification from anywhere in the United States
- A mailing address to ensure they receive their food stamps, employment and healthcare communications, as well as letters from family and friends
- Placement into detox/addiction treatment if needed
- For those without insurance, free healthcare through our partnership with St. Joseph's Mercy Care

The Angels program also:

- Assists Guests in securing permanent housing
- Assists Guests in applying for Social Security Disability benefits to which they are entitled
- Accompanying Guests to medical and other appointments as needed
